Please try to follow these eco friendly guidelines suggested by students of South Wilts 2014.

Conserving heat

- Conserve heat in buildings by closing doors
- Ask teachers to turn off radiators if it's too hot rather than opening windows
- Close windows at the end of the day

Saving energy

- Use natural light in class rooms by opening blinds
- 🤗 Turn off computer monitors if they are not being used
- Always preview rather than print
- Switch off lights if rooms are empty or if you are last to leave a room or at the end of the school day

Conserving water

- Turn off taps
- Drink from the water fountains instead of buying bottled water

Saving resources

- Save paper as much as you can print and write on both sides of paper
- Use fewer paper towels
- Use plates instead of takeout trays in the canteen

- Re-use paper as scrap paper
- Recycle all paper, card, plastic and metal by using the green recycling bins

- Use public transport or walk and cycle to school if possible
