January mock exams

- Students new to the school, will have had no experience sitting exams at South Wilts
- Mock exams have been completed in all subjects.
- Results have been analysed to identify students that require extra support
- Hopefully students have learnt from their experience

Year 12 to 13 options process

- Most students are **currently studying 4 subjects**
- On Wednesday, we are asking students to decide which subjects they want to continue next year.
- Most students will **continue with 3 subjects**.
- We will enter them for the AS exam in the subject they are dropping.
- They may **choose** to sit the AS exam in another subject as well, but this may incur a **cost**

Maths – Modular, so all students sit AS exam this summer

Physics – Linear, may sit AS this year

English – Linear, may sit AS this year

History – Linear, only sit AS at the end of next year

Year 12 to 13 Making Choices

- Most students choose **three subjects** to continue to A level
- Some include **General Studies A level** as a fourth choice or **Further Maths**
- **Extended Project** will be an option
- Very few students choose to **continue all four** subjects to A level
- We will do our best to ensure that all students are able to study the courses they wish.
- However, if they change the choices later in the year we cannot guarantee that the combination will be possible

- Decide on AS entries and which subject they will not continue with, **Wednesday 8 February**
- AS exams **mid may to mid June**
- End of year exams w/b **Monday 19 June**
- Results Day on **Thursday 17 August**
- Year 13 courses finalised **Monday 4 September**
