Year 9 Homework Timetable

Welcome to another year at South Wilts. I am sending you a copy of your daughter's homework timetable. The Home and Out of Class Work Policy is available for you to view via the school's website www.swgs.wilts.sch.uk under Parent Information / General Information / Policies. I hope that it will be possible for you to ensure that your daughter has a quiet place in which to study and that you will encourage her by taking an interest in her work.

As you already know each student is given a school diary in which she should write down: the subject, the nature of the homework and the date by which the work must be completed, as meeting deadlines is part of the learning process. Can I remind you that parents are asked to sign the diary by Monday morning each week. There is a space on the right-hand side of the page for you to make comments if necessary. Form Tutors will check the diary and sign it every fortnight.

We hope this method will enable home and school to work together in developing good working habits. Any student experiencing problems should be identified quickly and help can then be given. Should problems arise which mean your daughter cannot complete the tasks set, please let her Tutor know the reason, by letter or email, the following day. Alternatively, please write a note in her homework diary. It is particularly helpful for us to know if homework tasks are taking longer than the suitable amount of time. In Year 9 this remains as 30 minutes per homework subject.
